6 Days – 5 Nights School Itinerary



Day 1 - Arrival in Athens

Fly to Athens. On arrival, meet our representative who will escort you to your hotel for check-in. Later in the evening you will be picked up from your hotel for a tour of Athens by night. The tour starts with a visit to the main Greek port of Piraeus, passing by the most important points of the city before arriving in Plaka. Short pleasant walk through the old unique Athens city to a popular taverns for dinner with live bouzouki music and Greek folk dancing. Overnight at hotel in Athens.

Day 2 - Athens & City Tour

We start the day with a visit to Panathinaiko Stadium which was the cradle of the first Olympic Games that took place in 1896. We then then pass by all the major city sites before reaching the Acropolis, the crowning beauty and glory of Ancient Athens. We conclude the tour with the visit to the new ACROPOLIS museum, considered one of the most important archaeological museums in the world. Break for lunch in a local restaurant followed by a visit to the Athens Planetarium. Back in the hotel later in the afternoon for dinner. Overnight in Athens.

Day 3 - Day Cruise to islands

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the port to embark on a one-day cruise that will visit 3 beautiful islands in the Saronic gulf. Poros, Hydra & Aegina. You will enjoy your lunch on board the ship while at sea in the Aegean. You will return to Athens at 1930 hrs where you will be transferred to the hotel for dinner and overnight.

Day 4 - Full Day at Delphi

After breakfast get ready to depart for your full day tour to Delphi, one of the most important religious sanctuaries of the ancient Greek world, dedicated to Apollo and situated on the lower southern slopes of Mount Parnassus. It was the seat of the Delphic Oracle, whose riddling responses to a wide range of questions were delivered by the Pythia. Visit the archaeological site and the Museum where one can admire numerous archeological treasures. Following lunch, we return to Athens with a midway stop in the picturesque mountain village of Arachova. Dinner back in the hotel.

Day 5 - Full Day at Argolis

After breakfast we drive to Mycenae and visit the archaeological site, home to the kingdom of mythical Agamemnon. Visit the Palace, the Lionesses Gate and the tomb of Agamemnon. After lunch we drive through Argos and Nauplia before we arrive in Epidaurus to visit the famous ancient theatre. This Unesco world heritage listed monument is reputed to be the birthplace of Apollo's son Asklepios 'the healer' and was the most celebrated healing center of the classical world. Epidaurus is probably most famous for its theatre, one of the best preserved classical Greek buildings and still used today due to its amazing acoustics. Dinner back in the hotel in Athens.

Day 6 - Departure from Athens

After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for your flight back home. Note : Minimum 20 pax required to organize this tour.
