DAY 1: Overnight Flight

Depart the United States today, as you embark upon your 9-day European Performance Tour!

DAY 2: Fussen (D)

Arrival in the Bavarian city of Munich, Germany! Your tour manager escort will greet you at the airport and transfer you into the city center by private motor-coach. Begin exploration right away, with a walking tour of the historic city center of Munich with a local guide. There is free time for lunch, perhaps at the famous Hofbrauhaus. Continue on to the nearby city of Fussen to check-in to your hotel, and rest after your trans-Atlantic journey. There is an arrival briefing presented by your escort, followed by dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 3: Fussen (B/D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, served each morning throughout your tour. Today's excursion brings you to King Ludwig II's <u>Schloss Neuschwanstein</u> for a guided tour. In creating the castle, Ludwig was inspired by the operas of his friend, composer Richard Wagner; much later, Disney found inspiration for his own Sleeping Beauty castle. Return to the musical town of Fussen, known for the creation of Europe's first lute-makers gild in 1562, as well as its organ building traditions. A tour with local guide includes entrance to the <u>Heritage Museum</u> and it's collection of historic stringed instruments, as well as the medieval town center to see and hear some of the preserved baroque organs. *This evening present your debut European concert debut! There is time scheduled for a warm-up rehearsal at your venue.* Afterward, enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 4: Salzburg (B/D)

Depart the region of Hohenschwangau this morning, and head for the Austrian border. Along the way, visit <u>Hitler's Eagle's Nest</u>. Built as a teahouse for the Third Reich, the building survived the bombing and battles of World War II and become a recreation center for the U.S. military until the area was returned to Germany in the 1990's. Your stop includes the original brass elevator that runs through the heart of the mountain, and takes you into the Eagle's Nest building at the top of the mountain. You will see some of the most spectacular views of the German and Austrian Alps today! Continue on to the city of Salzburg, and check into your hotel. Enjoy a special folklore dinner tonight!

DAY 5: Salzburg (B/D)

A local guide leads you on a half-day sightseeing tour, to familiarize you with Salzburg where "The hills are alive with the sound of music." Entrances are provided to Mozart's Birthplace, Hellbrunn Palace's trick fountains, Mirabell Gardens, and the Salzburger Dom. Your tour ends at Hohensalzburg, where you will reach the fortress by funicular for great views of the city. Enjoy free time to further explore with your escort this afternoon. A concert in Salzburg is scheduled for this evening! Dinner is included at a local restaurant this evening.

DAY 6: Prague (B/D)

Your adventure continues, as you depart Austria and head north. Along the way, visit Cesky Krumlov; a UNESCO World Heritage Site. A guided walking tour allows for exploration of the <u>castle complex</u> and entrance to the tower, with expansive views of the Old Town. Your escort will make suggestions for lunch, and shopping for mementos. Your day ends in Prague, the capital city of the historic region of Bohemia and the Czech Republic. Dinner is provided to the group at a local restaurant.

DAY 7: Prague (B/D)

Visit a local school or community ensemble this morning, for a cultural exchange and joint performance! Later this afternoon, share a sobering visit to one of World War II's most recognizable concentration camps. Just outside of Prague, Terezin was used as a model for Red Cross inspections. However, like other Nazi camps, its prisoners met with slave labor and death. Return to Prague, where this evening your buffet dinner cruise along the Vltava River provides a well-lit and enjoyable view of this magical city.

DAY 8: Prague (B/D)

Today's guided sightseeing tour of Prague shows you the important sites of the city, including <u>Prague Castle with St. Vitus Cathedral</u>, the Charles Bridge, Old Town Square and the Astronomical Clock, the Lesser Town Square and St. Nicolas Church. Afterward follow in the steps of one of Prague's famous composers, with a visit to the <u>Museum of Antonin Dvorak</u>. *This evening, prepare for your concert finale! A warm-up rehearsal is provided.* Afterward, enjoy a final dinner and celebrate your successful performance tour, with shared stories of your time abroad.

DAY 9: Departure (B)

After breakfast, your escort will assist with hotel check-out and transfer to the airport. Say a final goodbye, and depart on your return flights home.

Terms and Conditions

LAND DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

GROUP REVIEW:

90 Days Prior: Preliminary status

45 Days Prior: Finalization of group with names and rooming lists

CANCELATION POLICY

No charges are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 30 days prior to the commencement of Tumlare Corporation, Inc. services. However, services which have been prepaid by Tumlare Corporation, Inc. on behalf of individual clients may be subject to a cancellation fee (e.g. theatre tickets etc.). Cancellations within 30 days of departure will be on case by case basis. Tumlare will do its best to waive as much fees involved as possible and will pass on only out of pocket charges. Cancellation fees will not exceed 20% of package price between 29-7 days prior to arrival. Anything

after 7 days will be decided on a case by case basis.

Passengers canceling within the 30-day period may be charged the following maximum percentages of the tour price:

SINGLE ROOMS

The single supplement rate is quoted on the basis that single rooms shall not exceed approximately 20% if the total rooms required, unless otherwise agreed and confirmed. Some hotels may charge a further fee should the group exceed this configuration.

FOC for each group will be in a single room.

BAGGAGE

When porterage of baggage is included in a program, it is based upon a maximum of 1 piece of standard airline baggage per person. Passengers bringing baggage in excess of this amount may incur a surcharge. For the sake of passenger comfort, Tumlare Corporation, Inc. recommends that passengers limit baggage to 1 suitcase per person plus 1 carry on.

AIR DEVIATIONS:

A \$100.00 deviation charge is applied to any passenger wishing to extend his/her stay in the original return gateway, as well as weekend surcharges if applicable. Passengers wishing to return from a different gateway will be charged the deviation fee plus any additional costs related to the new gateway.

ITEMS NOT INCLUDED

Tumlare Corporation, Inc. programs do not include items of a personal nature such as laundry, hotel extras, telephone charges and drinks with meals (unless otherwise stated in a proposal). All passengers are responsible for settling such accounts prior to their return to the USA. Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included.

TAXES

As of the date of this proposal local and central government taxes are included for all services as levied by the governments of the USA and countries visited as specified. In the unlikely event that tax structures are amended at any time prior to the travel date, Tumlare will pass on all such additional taxes to the travel agent or group organizer, for collection. Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE AND FUEL SURCHARGES

All prices are quoted using the prevailing rate of exchange between the Euro and the USD from the date the original offer was made. If the rate of exchange changes by more than 4%, Tumlare reserves the right to revise the selling rates according to the current exchange rate between the Euro and the USD.

UNL/Tumlare reserves the right to change the price of the tour/program before it commences due to fuel surcharges, currency fluctuations, tariff increases from common carriers and suppliers, etc. If there is a surcharge to be applied such notice will be given no later than 45 days prior to the start of the tour or program.

Tumlare Corporation, Inc. strongly recommends that all passengers be adequately insured for medical expenses, baggage loss or damage and trip cancellation or interruption. This is the responsibility of individual tour participants. Individual coverage is available through our USA offices if required.

VISA & PASSPORTS

As of the time of going to print, US citizens require a full and valid passport to enter the European Community. Non US Citizens may require an entry visa and should check with the appropriate local consulate offices, allowing good time to complete the necessary paperwork prior to departing the USA.

PAYMENTS

Tour payments should be by agency check and made payable to "Tumlare Travel Organization, Inc."; Credit cards (MasterCard and Visa) are accepted for final payment but are subjected to a fee of 3%.

TOUR CONDUCTOR TICKETS

Earned tour conductor tickets that include air do not include any air taxes and fees as levied by the carrier. Earned tour conductor tickets are based upon double occupancy. Please note that tour conductor tickets are based on full paying passengers. I.E. 1 free for every twenty full paying passengers means the 21st passenger is free.

RESPONSIBILITY

If Tumlare Corporation, Inc. has to cancel a tour or is unable to carry out all services due to circumstances beyond our control, we will do all possible to secure services of comparable or better standard or refund all monies in full. Tumlare Corporation, Inc. accepts no responsibility for loss or additional expenses incurred due to delays, changes, omissions or errors made by our suppliers including but not limited to air, sea, ground transportation, war, weather, quarantine and strikes. All persons working with Tumlare Corporation, Inc. will be deemed to have accepted the conditions contained herein by submitting a booking deposit.

CLAIMS

Any claims must be made no later than 1 month after the end of the tour
