DAY 1: Overnight Flight

Begin your Performance Tour, as you depart the United States on your trans-Atlantic overnight flight!

DAY 2: Budapest (D)

Your full-time tour manager escort will greet you upon your arrival in the capital city of Budapest, straddling both sides of the Danube River. Hungarian classical music is well known throughout the world, with composers such as Béla Bartók and Franz Liszt, and Budapest has well preserved its cultural and folk traditions. Transfer to your centrally located hotel, where your escort will provide a familiarization briefing and walking tour of your neighborhood. Tonight, celebrate with dinner, music, and dancing at a local Gypsy restaurant serving traditional Hungarian fare.

DAY 3: Budapest (B/D)

Enjoy breakfast at the hotel, provided each morning of your trip. Your exploration starts right away, with a half-day sightseeing tour with local guide of the architectural gem of Budapest, often considered the “Little Paris of Central Europe” and the “Pearl of the Danube”. Buda and Pest, along with Óbuda, were united into a single city in 1873. Your guide will educate you of Hungary’s thousand-year history as you visit Castle Hill, and the 13th century Matthias Church; you will also see Parliament, the Royal Palace and the Chain Bridge. Visit the Basilica of St. Stephen, the city’s largest church which houses Szent Jobb (the mummified Holy Right Hand of St. Stephen). Enjoy some free time with your escort to wander the cobble-stoned streets of old Buda and enjoy lunch on your own. This afternoon, share a guided tour of the 19th century Budapest State Opera House. **Present your concert debut in Budapest! A warm-up rehearsal is scheduled at your venue, prior to your performance.** Afterward, dinner is served at a local restaurant.

DAY 4: Budapest (B/D)

This morning visit the prestigious Liszt Ferenc Music Academy, rich with history and prestigious alumni. The Art Nouveau building is home to manuscripts donated by Franz Liszt, among other treasures, and has its own performance venue. Alternatively, you might visit the Bela Bartok Conservatory. **Join a local school or community ensemble this afternoon, for a joint concert and exchange.** The evening is free for further exploration on your own, and you may wish to catch one of the musical offerings at Vigadó Concert Hall or the Hungarian State Opera, subject to availability and

schedule. There is also the opportunity to visit one of the city's Turkish-era thermal spas; your escort can assist with suggestions and arrangements. Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 5: Bratislava (B/D)

Depart Hungary today for the nearby Slovakian capital, the ancient city of Bratislava. There is time for a stop in beautiful Szentendre for a walk with your escort. This baroque small town is famous for its Hungarian artists and features many galleries, museums and monuments. Along the way, you will also pass by the charming towns of Visegrad and Esztergom! Upon arrival in Bratislava, meet with a local guide for an afternoon sightseeing tour of the easily walkable historic city centre, with its cobblestones, plazas, and "men at work" sculptures. Visit the Old Square, and also see Parliament, Sant' Martin Cathedral, Michael's Gate, and climb up to Bratislava Castle to experience the contrasting vista of 18th century Rococo buildings with communist-era constructions! There is time to wander through old town; be sure to sit back at one of the many cafes for traditional pancakes, gelato, and the area's thick hot chocolate! Dinner is served at a local restaurant this evening.

DAY 6: Bratislava (B/D)

This morning visit the Johann Nepomuk Hummel Museum, featuring the life and works the composer, his musical instruments, and samples of his work. The remainder of the day is free to spend exploring on your own, or with your escort. ***This evening perform a joint concert in Bratislava, with a local ensemble!*** Enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

DAY 7: Vienna (B/D)

This morning travel by coach from Bratislava to the historical music center of Vienna! There is free time for lunch, allowing for the opportunity to savor one of Vienna's famed desserts, sachertorte! Afterward, meet with a local guide, for a panoramic tour to see the magnificent buildings of the Ringstrasse, the Opera House, the Hofburg, and the Karlskirche, with entrance to St. Stephan's Cathedral; be sure to take in the famous lacy spires! You will also stop at the Zentralfriedhof, one of the largest cemeteries in the world, to visit the final resting place of composers such as Beethoven, Brahms, Schubert, and Strauss. A highlight is your visit to Schloss Schönbrunn, summer home to the Habsburg family, birthplace of Marie-Antoinette, and where Mozart often performed. Dinner.

DAY 8: Vienna (B/D)

This morning visit Mozart's House for a guided tour; it is here where he wrote "The Marriage of Figaro". Enjoy free time for further exploration of the city with your escort. ***This afternoon present your concert finale, in Vienna! There is time for a warm-up rehearsal at your venue.*** Celebrate your last night in Europe with a "Heurigen" traditional family style dinner in the village of Gumpoldskirchen, with local music! Share new memories of your time abroad, and toast your successful performance tour!

DAY 9: Departure (B)

After a final breakfast at the hotel, your escort will transfer you to the airport and assist with check-in for your return flights to the United States!

LAND DEPOSIT REQUIREMENTS

GROUP REVIEW:

90 Days Prior: Preliminary status

45 Days Prior: Finalization of group with names and rooming lists

CANCELATION POLICY

No charges are levied for individual passengers canceling up to 30 days prior to the commencement of Tumlare Corporation, Inc. services. However, services which have been prepaid by Tumlare Corporation, Inc. on behalf of individual clients may be subject to a cancellation fee (e.g. theatre tickets etc.). Cancellations within 30 days of departure will be on case by case basis. Tumlare will do its best to waive as much fees involved as possible and will pass on only out of pocket charges. Cancellation fees will not exceed 20% of package price between 29-7 days prior to arrival. Anything after 7 days will be decided on a case by case basis.

Passengers canceling within the 30-day period may be charged the following maximum percentages of the tour price:

SINGLE ROOMS

The single supplement rate is quoted on the basis that single rooms shall not exceed approximately 20% if the total rooms required, unless otherwise agreed and confirmed. Some hotels may charge a further fee should the group exceed this configuration.

FOC for each group will be in a single room.

BAGGAGE

When portorage of baggage is included in a program, it is based upon a maximum of 1 piece of standard airline baggage per person. Passengers bringing baggage in excess of this amount may incur a surcharge. For the sake of passenger comfort, Tumlare Corporation, Inc. recommends that passengers limit baggage to 1 suitcase per person plus 1 carry on.

AIR DEVIATIONS:

A \$100.00 deviation charge is applied to any passenger wishing to extend his/her stay in the original return gateway, as well as weekend surcharges if applicable. Passengers wishing to return from a different gateway will be charged the deviation fee plus any additional costs related to the new gateway.

ITEMS NOT INCLUDED

Tumlare Corporation, Inc. programs do not include items of a personal nature such as laundry, hotel extras, telephone charges and drinks with meals (unless otherwise stated in a proposal). All passengers are responsible for settling such accounts prior to their return to the USA. Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included.

TAXES

As of the date of this proposal local and central government taxes are included for all services as levied by the governments of the USA and countries visited as specified. In the unlikely event that tax structures are amended at any time prior to the travel date, Tumlare will pass on all such additional taxes to the travel agent or group organizer, for collection. Airport and airline taxes and fees are not included.

CURRENCY EXCHANGE AND FUEL SURCHARGES

All prices are quoted using the prevailing rate of exchange between the Euro and the USD from the date the original offer was made. If the rate of exchange changes by more than 4%, Tumlare reserves the right to revise the selling rates according to the current exchange rate between the Euro and the USD.

UNL/Tumlare reserves the right to change the price of the tour/program before it commences due to fuel surcharges, currency fluctuations, tariff increases from common carriers and suppliers, etc. If there is a surcharge to be applied such notice will be given no later than 45 days prior to the start of the tour or program.

INSURANCE

Tumlare Corporation, Inc. strongly recommends that all passengers be adequately insured for medical expenses, baggage loss or damage and trip cancellation or interruption. This is the responsibility of individual tour participants. Individual coverage is available through our USA offices if required.

VISA & PASSPORTS

As of the time of going to print, US citizens require a full and valid passport to enter the European Community. Non US Citizens may require an entry visa and should check with the appropriate local consulate offices, allowing good time to complete the necessary paperwork prior to departing the USA.

PAYMENTS

Tour payments should be by agency check and made payable to "Tumlare Travel Organization, Inc."; Credit cards (MasterCard and Visa) are accepted for final payment but are subjected to a fee of 3%.

TOUR CONDUCTOR TICKETS

Earned tour conductor tickets that include air do not include any air taxes and fees as levied by the carrier. Earned tour conductor tickets are based upon double occupancy. Please note that tour conductor tickets are based on full paying passengers. I.E. 1 free for every twenty full paying passengers means the 21st passenger is free.

RESPONSIBILITY

If Tumlare Corporation, Inc. has to cancel a tour or is unable to carry out all services due to circumstances beyond our control, we will do all possible to secure services of comparable or better standard or refund all monies in full. Tumlare Corporation, Inc. accepts no responsibility for loss or additional expenses incurred due to delays, changes, omissions or errors made by our suppliers including but not limited to air, sea, ground transportation, war, weather, quarantine and strikes. All persons working with Tumlare Corporation, Inc. will be deemed to have accepted the conditions contained herein by submitting a booking deposit.

CLAIMS

Any claims must be made no later than 1 month after the end of the tour
