When to Travel

When you travel is entirely up to you. The most popular student travel time is typically February through June (peak season.) During this time, there is often an increased volume of student travelers throughout the country and abroad.

You may see slight price increases at attractions, accommodations, transportation, etc. and a decrease in availability. If you're planning spring travel, we strongly encourage you to book your trip as early as possible to secure the best rates and products.



Great Benefits When You Book Early.

If you are flexible with your travel times, many groups find that fall and summer travel (off-peak) are ideal for student groups. Off-peak travel often translates to better group rates and less crowded student destinations. You may also find there's better student participation, unique or "VIP" experiences, and (sometimes) even better weather!



Securing Approval

Once you have a tentative outline of where you want to go and when, it's time to go to your administration for approval. Every district has different requirements for greenlighting your trip, but we've outlined some general guidelines for best practices in the link below.


